- 2. Emergency Services (e.g. police, fire, sheriff, defense, town public works, security)
- 3. Food and Agricultural (e.g. retail food, restaurants, food manufacturers & processors & distributors, farming)
- 4. Energy (e.g. electricity, gas, oil)
- 5. Water and Wastewater (e.g. water authorities & systems, treatment facilities, distribution and testing)
- 6. Transportation Systems (e.g. aviation, highway & motor carrier, maritime, mass transit & passenger rail, freight rail, postal & shipping)
- 7. Communications and Information Technology (e.g. networks, systems, physical & cyber infrastructure)
- 8. Government Operations and Other Community-Based Essential Functions (e.g. critical & certain other government workers, courts, elections, licensing)
- 9. Critical Manufacturing (e.g. primary metals, machinery, electrical equipment, appliances)
- 10. Financial Services (e.g. depository institutions, investment products, insurance, credit)
